



To Whom It May Concern:

On March 16, 2020, the Health Officers of the Counties of Alameda, Contra Costa, Marin, San Francisco, San Mateo and Santa Clara issued Shelter Orders (the "Shelter Orders"):

Directing all individuals living in the county to shelter at their place of residence except that they may leave to provide or receive certain essential services or engage in certain essential activities and work for essential businesses and governmental services: exempting individuals experiencing homelessness from the shelter in place order but urging them to find shelter and government agencies to provide it; directing all businesses and governmental agencies to cease non-essential operations at physical locations in the county; prohibiting all non-essential gatherings of any number of individuals: and ordering cessation of all non-essential travel.

Please be advised that as a Supplier to one or more Essential Businesses, employees of Inneos fall under an exception to the Shelter Orders.

1. The Shelter Orders contain exceptions allowing individuals to leave their residences only to perform certain "Essential Activities" or to Perform work providing essential products and services at an "Essential Business."
2. One or more of Inneos active customers provides infection prevention, contamination prevention, microbial reduction, and surgical support systems, products, services, and technologies to healthcare, scientific, research, food, and industrial customers throughout the San Francisco Bay area. These customers qualify as a Healthcare Operation and therefore as an Essential Business under the Shelter Orders.
3. In Section 10(f)(xv), the Shelter Orders define Essential Businesses to include "Businesses that supply other Essential Businesses with the support or supplies necessary to operate."
